The Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence began its second year, by co-organizing The International Conference on Applied Business and Economics – Paris, 1-3 of September. The main goal of the conference was to provide a good opportunity for academics and people from the economic environment to exchange ideas in an interdisciplinary way about business and economics, in the European context.

In addition to presentation of the study "Discussing the role of education in stimulating economic development in the framework of Europe 2020 Strategy: Evidence from the South-Eastern Europe" (authors: Monica Raileanu Szeles -Transylvania University Brasov- and Ileana Tache -Transylvania University Brasov), the Jean Monnet project manager - prof Ileana Tache - was one of the conference chairs.

The selected papers will be published in prestigious journals, such as: European Research Studies Journal, International Journal of Economics and Business Administration, International Journal of Computational Economics and Econometrics, International Journal in Business and Economic Sciences and Applied Research, Journal of Economic Asymmetries, Journal of Business and Economic Studies, The International Journal of Finance, Global Journal of Finance and Banking Issues.



Starting with October, a new session of weekly seminars began. Two special guests were invited to lecture about European integration issues: Aurelian Leonard Danu - Head of Communication Department of National Liberal Party - and Mara Mares - expert in European Public Policies. They presented the theme "Bioeconomy and welfare state indicators in the context of Europe 2020 Strategy".
