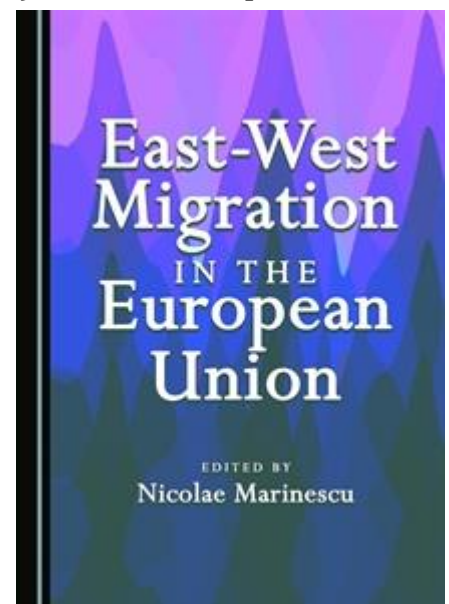

As a result of the workshop "EAST-WEST MIGRATION IN THE EUROPEAN UNION", organized in March 2016, and under the supervision of Assoc prof Nicolae Marinescu (member of the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence), a book was published at Cambridge Scholars Publishing House.

The book titled *East-West Migration in the European Union* offers a structured view of the delicate problem of migration from Eastern Europe to the Western European Union countries in the recent international context, paying attention to some particular features of migration flow.
